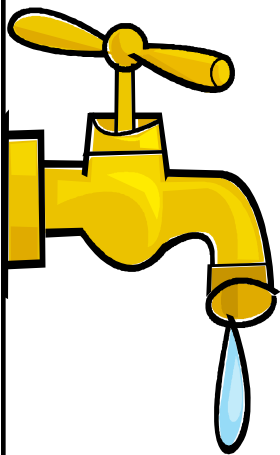
EASTER SUNDAY!

Tour City of Columbia Water Works

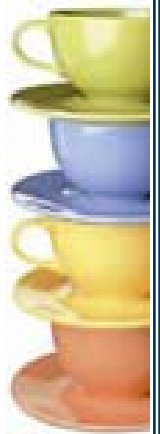
Learn about the series of treatment techniques that are followed to ensure the water from lake Murray and the Broad River is safe for citizens of the Midlands to drink. On Thursday, March

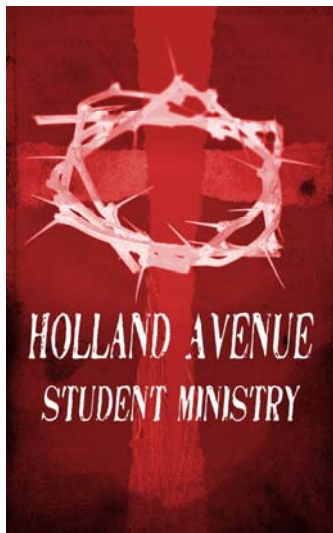
