A special time of worship will be held for our children. Sandwiches and ice cream for all will follow in the fellowship hall.

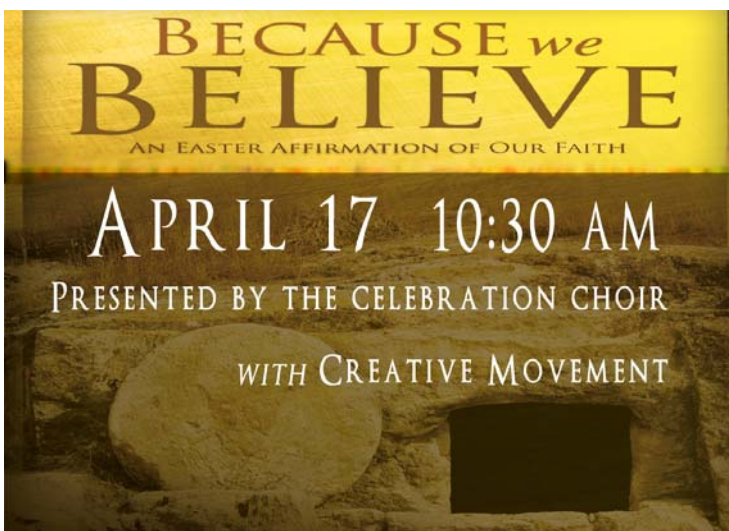

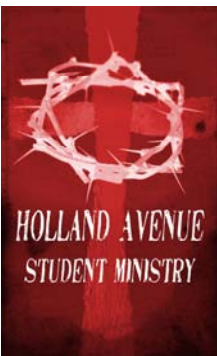
Important Meeting
