Summer is over and school is in, routines are becoming, well, routine again. However, there is nothing routine about children's ministry in the fall. There is a lot of planning and activity going on. Below are a few highlights for your calendar:

4th and 5th Grade Lock-In is October 21st. This is a Friday and the children have a school holiday. That evening we will go to Maize Quest in Gilbert. In addition to going through the maze we will have a hayride, sit by a campfire and make s'mores! Sign up and permission forms are required. This year's Hallelujah Hoedown will be Monday, October 31st from 6-8pm. We will have a western theme this year

This is foundational truth which they must know and believe in order to combat the stories of evolution so prevalently taught.

I'm so proud of our children. I can see them growing spiritually. Here's what a few of our children are doing for the Lord:

One of our boys recently boldly witnessed to a friend in the backseat of their car. His mother said he went passed the "Do you know God" question and went straight to explaining why we need forgiveness of sin!

One of our girls just began a Bible study with a group of friends at recess. What a testimony to others that they would give up their play time for reading the Word of God!
